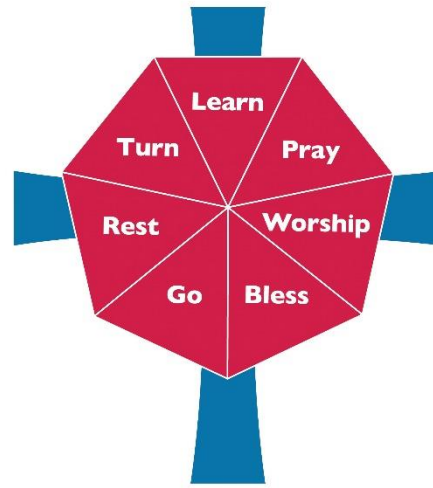
## Worship
